Once the district has completed at least two trainings, they can use the driving simulator. The simulator is designed to reinforce and practice the techniques employees learned from the trainings. The simulator is connected to the district's vehicle that employees drive regularly. Sensors are connected to the gas and brake while the wheels are placed on free spinning plates. Drivers have the option to wear virtual reality goggles or watch a 40" television screen. Employees can experience multiple scenarios while in a safe environment and are given 10-15 minutes in the simulator.
