**NOVEMBER 6, 2018 GENERAL ELECTION**

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**Benton County**

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*Local Option Levy (Measure 02-120)*

Taxing District: Ridgewood Road District  
Term: One-Year  
Purpose: Fund slurry and chip sealing (last completed in 2008)  
Cost: \$3.00 per \$1,000 of assessed value; \$60,700 in additional tax or \$1,145 per household (53 households)  
**Election Results:**     **Pass (73%)**             **Fail (27%)**

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**Curry County**

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*Motor Vehicle Tax (Measure 08-094)*

Taxing District: City of Gold Beach  
Purpose: Fund construction, reconstruction, improvement, repair, maintenance, and operation of streets and transportation infrastructure  
Cost: \$0.01 per gallon through the year and an additional \$0.03 per gallon from May 1 through October 31 on motor vehicle fuel dealers.  
**Election Results:**     **Pass (37%)**             **Fail (63%)**

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**Jackson County**

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*Service District Annexation (Measure 15-177)*

Taxing District: City of Shady Cove  
Purpose: Annex Shady Cove Sewer District into the Rogue Valley Sewer Services District  
**Election Results:**     **Pass (62%)**             **Fail (38%)**

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## Lane County

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*General Obligation Bond (Measure 20-296)*

Taxing District: City of Springfield  
Term: Six-Year  
Purpose: Fund City street repair  
Cost: \$0.50 per \$1,000 of assessed value. Estimated total tax collection \$10 million  
**Election Results:**  Pass (55%)  Fail (45%)

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## Multnomah County

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*General Obligation Bond (Measure 26-199)*

Taxing District: Metro Council  
Term: Issued over time in multiple series  
Purpose: Fund affordable housing for low-income families, seniors, veterans, people with disabilities; community oversight and independent financial audits  
Cost: \$0.24 per \$1,000 of assessed value. Estimated total tax collection \$652.8 million  
**Election Results:**  Pass (59%)  Fail (41%)
