

MISCELLANEOUS LOCAL MEASURES
NOVEMBER 6, 2018 GENERAL ELECTION

Baker County

Ordinance Adoption (Measure 01-84)

Taxing District: Baker County

Purpose: Ordinance to prohibit any infringement of the right to keep and bear arms; provides for fines of \$2,000 per individual and \$4,000 per corporation.

Election Results: **Pass (67%)** **Fail (33%)**

Ordinance Adoption (Measure 01-85)

Taxing District: City of Sumpter

Purpose: Ban medical marijuana processing sites, dispensaries, a recreational marijuana producers, processors, wholesalers, and retailers in the city; emergency clause takes immediate effect.

Election Results: **Pass (49.66%)** **Fail (50.34%) *1 vote margin**

Ordinance Adoption (Measure 01-86)

Taxing District: City of Haines

Purpose: Prohibit commercial marijuana processing sites, dispensaries, retailers, producers, processors, and wholesalers.

Election Results: **Pass (63%)** **Fail (37%)**

Ordinance Adoption (Measure 01-87)

Taxing District: City of Haines

Purpose: Impose tax on the sale of cannabis products by retailers and/or manufacturers.

Cost: 3% tax at point of sale.

Election Results: **Pass (90%)** **Fail (10%)**

Ordinance Adoption (Measure 01-89)

Taxing District: City of Unity

Purpose: Prohibit commercial marijuana processing sites, dispensaries, retailers, producers, processors, and wholesalers.

Election Results: **Pass (70%)** **Fail (30%)**

Clackamas County

Charter Amendment (Measure 03-537)

Taxing District: City of Lake Oswego
Purpose: Remove requirement to post notice of proposed ordinances in two public places.
Election Results: Pass (48.2%) Fail (51.8%)

Charter Amendment (Measure 03-538)

Taxing District: City of Lake Oswego
Purpose: Allow cancellation of up to three regular Council meetings each year; current charter requires council to hold regular meetings at least twice a month.
Election Results: Pass (69%) Fail (31%)

Charter Mandated Voter Approval (Measure 03-539)

Taxing District: City of Oregon City
Purpose: Authorize permanent and temporary use of Jon Storm and Sportcraft Boat Ramp parks by ODOT for I-205 widening; charter requires voter approval use of public parks.
Election Results: Pass (78%) Fail (22%)

Charter Mandated Voter Approval (Measure 03-543)

Taxing District: City of West Linn
Purpose: Authorize temporary use of park and open space by ODOT for I-205 widening (northwestern portion of 5300 River Street).
Election Results: Pass (84%) Fail (16%)

Charter Mandated Voter Approval (Measure 03-544)

Taxing District: City of West Linn
Purpose: Authorize temporary use of park and open space by ODOT for I-205 widening (northeastern portion of 5350 River Street).
Election Results: Pass (82%) Fail (18%)

Clatsop County

Ordinance Adoption (Measure 04-193)

Taxing District: Clatsop County
Purpose: Impose tax on the sale of marijuana items by marijuana retailers in unincorporated areas of the county
Cost: 3% point of sale tax.
Election Results: Pass (71%) Fail (29%)

Ordinance Adoption (Measure 04-199)

Taxing District: City of Gearhart
Purpose: Reduce the city's taxes on recreational marijuana to the legal limit of three percent on the sale of recreational marijuana items by licensed retailers in the city and repeal the city's tax on medical marijuana.
Cost: Previous tax imposed was 10% on recreational and 5% on medical marijuana; tax on recreational will be set at the legal limit of 3%.
Election Results: Pass (72%) Fail (28%)

Columbia County

Ordinance Adoption (05-270)

Taxing District: Columbia County
Purpose: Ordinance to prohibit any infringement of the right to keep and bear arms.
Election Results: Pass (55%) Fail (45%)

Ordinance Adoption (Measure 05-271)

Taxing District: City of Clatskanie
Purpose: Prohibit operation of registered medical marijuana processing sites and dispensaries and licensed recreational marijuana producers, processors, wholesalers, and retailers.
Election Results: Pass (47%) Fail (53%)

Local Option Levy (Measure 05-272)

Taxing District: Rainier Cemetery District
Term: Five-Year
Purpose: Fund operations by hiring part time support staff and equipment replacement for twelve cemeteries.
Cost: \$0.07 per \$1,000 of assessed value. Estimated total tax collection \$598,181.
Election Results: Pass (36%) Fail (64%)

Coos County

Repeal of Ordinance (Measure 06-168)

Taxing District: Coos County
Purpose: Repeal of county ordinance adopting amendments to the North Bay Urban Renewal Plan.
Election Results: Pass (42%) Fail (58%)

Ordinance Adoption (Measure 06-169)

Taxing District: City of Coquille
Purpose: Impose a tax on the sale of marijuana items by recreational marijuana retailers in the city.
Cost: 3% tax at point of sale.
Election Results: Pass (76%) Fail (24%)

Advisory Vote (Measure 06-170)

Taxing District: Coos County
Purpose: Nonbinding advisory vote regarding whether the county should be able to tax commercial growing of recreational and medical marijuana.
Election Results: Pass (71%) Fail (29%)

Crook County

Local Option Levy Renewal (Measure 07-065)

Taxing District: Crook County
Term: Four-Year
Purpose: Fund building maintenance, staffing, and collection development of the Bowman Museum.
Cost: \$0.06 per \$1,000 of assessed value. Total estimated tax collection \$608,716.
Election Results: Pass (83%) Fail (17%)

Deschutes County

Ordinance Adoption (Measure 09-122)

Taxing District: City of Sisters
Purpose: Allow operation of licensed recreational marijuana producers, processors, wholesalers, and retailers, and registered medical marijuana processor and dispensaries in the city.
Election Results: Pass (44%) Fail (56%)

Ordinance Adoption (Measure 09-123)

Taxing District: City of Sisters
Purpose: Impose a tax on the sale of marijuana items by licensed recreational marijuana retailers in the city.
Cost: 3% tax at point of sale.
Election Results: Pass (82%) Fail (18%)

Douglas County

Ordinance Adoption (10-165)

Taxing District: Douglas County
Purpose: Ordinance preserving right to bear arms and related rights under the United States and Oregon Constitutions.
Election Results: Pass (74%) Fail (26%)

Hood River County

Ordinance Adoption (Measure 14-062)

Taxing District: Hood River County
Purpose: Impose a tax on the sale of marijuana items by licensed recreational marijuana retailers in unincorporated areas of the county.
Cost: 3% tax at point of sale.
Election Results: Pass (74%) Fail (26%)

Charter Amendment (Measure 14-063)

Taxing District: City of Cascade Locks
Purpose: Amend charter to ensure plurality election following a city council vacancy.
Election Results: Pass (68%) Fail (32%)

Ordinance Continuation (Measure 14-064)

Taxing District: City of Cascade Locks
Purpose: Continuation of previously established EMS service fee to fund EMS by enacting Ordinance No. 449.
Cost: Amount of fee will not increase and cannot exceed: \$6.00/month for residential meters; \$7.00/month for commercial and public agency meters; \$8.00/month for residential meters in South Bank utility area; and \$9.00/month for commercial and public agency meters in South Bank utility area.
Election Results: Pass (78%) Fail (22%)

Jackson County

Annexation of Sewer District (Measure 15-177)

Taxing District: City of Shady Cove
Purpose: Annex Shady Cove Sewer District into Rogue Valley Sewer Services District.
Election Results: **Pass (62%)** **Fail (38%)**

Ordinance Adoption (Measure 15-179)

Taxing District: City of Shady Cove
Purpose: Impose a tax on the sale of marijuana items by licensed recreational marijuana retailers in the city.
Cost: 3% tax at point of sale.
Election Results: **Pass (47%)** **Fail (53%)**

Ordinance Adoption (15-181)

Taxing District: Jackson County
Purpose: Expansion of the constitutional definition of firearms and prohibition on enforcement of laws that regulate their manufacture, sale, and possession.
Election Results: **Pass (44%)** **Fail (56%)**

Jefferson County

Ordinance Adoption (Measure 16-090)

Taxing District: City of Culver
Purpose: Prohibit medical marijuana processors, medical marijuana dispensaries, recreational marijuana producers, processors, wholesalers, and retailers in the city.
Election Results: **Pass (50.31%)** **Fail (49.69%) *3 vote margin.**

Josephine County

Ordinance Adoption (Measure 17-085)

Taxing District: City of Grants Pass
Purpose: Impose a tax on the sale of marijuana items by marijuana retailers in the city.
Cost: 3% tax at point of sale.
Election Results: **Pass (78%)** **Fail (22%)**

Ordinance Adoption (Measure 17-086)

Taxing District: City of Cave Junction
Purpose: Impose a tax on the retail sale of recreational marijuana in the city.
Cost: 3% tax at point of sale.
Election Results: **Pass (75%)** **Fail (25%)**

Advisory Vote (Measure 17-087)

Taxing District: Josephine County
Purpose: Nonbinding advisory regarding whether federal agencies administering public lands in the county should create, improve, and maintain a navigable road system.
Election Results: **Pass (84%)** **Fail (16%)**

Advisory Vote (Measure 17-088)

Taxing District: Josephine County
Purpose: Nonbinding advisory regarding whether the county should be able to tax production of recreational and medical marijuana.
Election Results: **Pass (75%)** **Fail (25%)**

Klamath County

Ordinance Adoption (18-110)

Taxing District: Klamath County
Purpose: Ordinance prohibiting any infringement on the right to keep and bear arms.
Election Results: **Pass (64%)** **Fail (36%)**

Local Option Levy Renewal (Measure 18-111)

Taxing District: Klamath County
Term: Five-Year
Purpose: Klamath County Museum operations.
Cost: \$0.05 per \$1,000 of assessed value. Total estimated tax collection \$1,170,935.
Election Results: **Pass (71%)** **Fail (29%)**

Ordinance Adoption (Measure 18-112)

Taxing District: City of Klamath Falls
Purpose: Impose a tax on the sale of marijuana items by marijuana retailers in the city.
Cost: 3% tax at point of sale.
Election Results: **Pass (54%)** **Fail (46%)**

Lake County

Ordinance Adoption (19-032)

Taxing District: Lake County
Purpose: Ordinance prohibiting any infringement on the right to keep and bear arms.
Election Results: **Pass (71%)** **Fail (29%)**

Ordinance Adoption (Measure 19-033)

Taxing District: City of Lakeview
Purpose: Impose a tax on the sale of marijuana items by marijuana retailers in the city.
Cost: 3% tax at point of sale.
Election Results: **Pass (85%)** **Fail (15%)**

Lane County

Charter Amendment (Measure 20-290)

Taxing District: Lane County
Purpose: Adopt "Score Then Automatic Runoff" method for counting candidate votes in local office races. Scores range from one to five.
Election Results: **Pass (47%)** **Fail (53%)**

Ordinance Adoption (Measure 20-293)

Taxing District: City of Dunes City
Purpose: Prohibit medical marijuana processors, medical marijuana dispensaries, recreational marijuana producers, processors, wholesalers, and retailers in the city.
Election Results: **Pass (63%)** **Fail (37%)**

Charter Amendment (Measure 20-294)

Taxing District: City of Dunes City
Purpose: Authority for Municipal Court Judge granted by state law unless limited by City Council; allow Council to contract for Municipal Judge services; allow Council to authorize Municipal Court at a location outside City limits.
Election Results: **Pass (36%)** **Fail (64%)**

Local Option Levy (Measure 20-295)

Taxing District: City of Dunes City
Term: Five-Year
Purpose: Fund general City operations.
Cost: \$0.05 per \$1,000 of assessed value. Total estimated tax collection \$6,078.50.

Election Results: Pass (27%) Fail (73%)

Lincoln County

Ordinance Adoption (21-189)

Taxing District: Lincoln County
Purpose: Ordinance prohibiting any infringement on the right to keep and bear arms.

Election Results: Pass (47%) Fail (53%)

Linn County

Ordinance Adoption (Measure 22-173)

Taxing District: City of Brownsville
Purpose: Prohibit new commercial marijuana facilities in the city.

Election Results: Pass (61%) Fail (39%)

Ordinance Adoption (22-174)

Taxing District: Linn County
Purpose: Ordinance prohibiting any infringement on the right to keep and bear arms.

Election Results: Pass (51%) Fail (49%)

Development Code Amendments (22-175)

Taxing District: City of Tangent
Purpose: Changes city development code regarding time, place, and manner limitations on certain marijuana uses, changes to some development process, and housekeeping changes.

Election Results: Pass (53%) Fail (47%)

County Surveyor (22-176)

Taxing District: Linn County
Purpose: Change the method of selection of the office of the Linn County Surveyor from an elective office to an appointed position.

Election Results: Pass (30%) Fail (70%)

Klamath County

Ordinance Adoption (Measure 18-112)

Taxing District: City of Klamath Falls
Purpose: Allows state-licensed medical marijuana dispensaries, recreational marijuana retailers, and recreational marijuana producers, processors, and wholesalers.

Election Results: **Pass (54%)** **Fail (46%)**

Marion County

Ordinance Adoption (Measure 24-430)

Taxing District: City of Gates
Purpose: Prohibit medical marijuana processors, medical marijuana dispensaries, recreational marijuana producers, processors, wholesalers, and retailers in the city.

Election Results: **Pass (42%)** **Fail (58%)**

Local Option Levy (Measure 24-434)

Taxing District: City of St. Paul
Term: Three-Year
Purpose: Fund general city operations.
Cost: \$1.50 per \$1,000 of assessed value. Total estimated tax collection \$178,548.

Election Results: **Pass (48%)** **Fail (52%)**

Charter Amendment (Measure 24-435)

Taxing District: City of Jefferson
Purpose: Require voter approval of annexations and clarify Mayor's authority.

Election Results: **Pass (68%)** **Fail (32%)**

Ordinance Adoption (Measure 24-436)

Taxing District: City of Turner
Purpose: Impose a tax on the sale of marijuana items by marijuana retailers in the city.
Cost: 3% tax at point of sale.

Election Results: **Pass (79%)** **Fail (21%)**

Ordinance Adoption (Measure 24-437)

Taxing District: City of Turner
Purpose: Prohibit new medical or recreational marijuana production, processing, wholesale or retail businesses in the city.
Election Results: Pass (64%) Fail (36%)

Malheur County

Ordinance Adoption (Measure 23-61)

Taxing District: City of Ontario
Purpose: Impose a tax on the sale of marijuana items by marijuana retailers in the city.
Cost: 3% tax at point of sale.
Election Results: Pass (57%) Fail (43%)

Multnomah County

Charter Amendment (Measure 26-200)

Taxing District: City of Portland
Purpose: Limit candidate contributions \$500 per individual and PACs, \$5,000 loan balances from candidate and \$100 from small donor committees. Limit expenditures for elected officials to \$5,000 independent expenditures to \$5,000 individual and \$10,000 per PAC. Requires certain funding disclosures for campaign contributions; allow campaign contributions by payroll deduction; fines for violations.
Election Results: Pass (88%) Fail (12%)

Gross Receipts Tax (26-201)

Taxing District: City of Portland
Term: Permanent
Purpose: Requires large retailers with annual revenue of \$1 billion or more to pay 1% surcharge on sales within the City to fund clean renewable, energy project and clean energy job training.
Election Results: Pass (65%) Fail (35%)

Tillamook County

Ordinance Adoption (Measure 29-155)

Taxing District: City of Manzanita
Purpose: Impose a tax on the sale of marijuana items by marijuana retailers in the city.
Cost: 3% tax at point of sale.
Election Results: Pass (63%) Fail (37%)

Merger of Water Districts (Measure 29-156)

Taxing District: Fairview Water District
Purpose: Merge Wilson River Water District with Fairview Water District, leaving Fairview as the surviving district.
Election Results: Pass (63%) Fail (37%)

Merger of Water Districts (Measure 29-157)

Taxing District: Wilson River Water District
Purpose: Merge Wilson River Water District with Fairview Water District, leaving Fairview as the surviving district.
Election Results: Pass (64%) Fail (36%)

Umatilla County

Ordinance Adoption (30-128)

Taxing District: Umatilla County
Purpose: Ordinance prohibiting any infringement on the right to keep and bear arms.
Election Results: Pass (65%) Fail (35%)

Union County

Ordinance Adoption (31-096)

Taxing District: Union County
Purpose: Expand constitutional definition of firearms and prohibit enforcement of laws that regulate their manufacture, sale, and possession.
Election Results: Pass (59%) Fail (41%)

Ordinance Adoption (Measure 31-097)

Taxing District: City of Imbler
Purpose: Prohibit medical marijuana processors, medical marijuana dispensaries, recreational marijuana producers, processors, wholesalers, and retailers in the city.
Election Results: **Pass (65%)** **Fail (35%)**

Wallowa County

Ordinance Adoption (Measure 32-042)

Taxing District: Wallowa County
Purpose: Repeal ban on marijuana businesses.
Election Results: **Pass (52%)** **Fail (48%)**

Wasco County

Ordinance Adoption (Measure 33-096)

Taxing District: City of Dufur
Purpose: Prohibit medical marijuana processors, medical marijuana dispensaries, recreational marijuana producers, processors, wholesalers, and retailers in the city.
Election Results: **Pass (52%)** **Fail (48%)**

Local Option Levy (Measure 33-099)

Taxing District: White River Health District
Term: Five-Year
Purpose: Fund general operations of the Deschutes Rim Health Clinic.
Cost: \$0.75 per \$1,000 of assessed value. Total estimated tax collection \$1,135,000.
Election Results: **Pass (48%)** **Fail (52 %)**

Wheeler County

Non Partisan County Commissioners (Measure 35-025)

Taxing District: Wheeler County
Purpose: Make County Commissioner positions nonpartisan starting in 2020.
Election Results: **Pass (62%)** **Fail (38%)**

Yamhill County

Code Amendment (Measure 36-197)

Taxing District: City of Lafayette

Purpose: Amend Municipal Code to allow keeping poultry and rabbits for personal purposes on property within the city limits.

Election Results: Pass (70%) Fail (30%)
